DIRECTIONS TO THE TEST/TRIAL SITE

From West: Take 1-80 East to 505 North . Take 505 to Allendale exit. Right on Allendale.
1&2/10 mile to driveway on Right. Big wooden posts with wrought iron gates.

From East: Take 1-80 West Dixon Avenue Exit. Right on Dixon Avenue go to end(3 miles).
Turn Right on Meridian Rd. Go 4/10 mile to Allendale, (sign is hard to see – behind a tree).
Left on Allendale. 2/10 mile to driveway on left. Big wooden posts with wrought iron gates.

DIRECTIONS FROM TEST/TRIAL SITE TO VETERINARIAN

UC Davis Veterinary Clinic (24 Hours) - (530) 752-0186

Turn right on Allendale, go 2/10 mile to end of road. Turn Right on Meridian. Go 4/10 mile to Dixon Avenue. Turn left on Dixon Avenue and go 3 miles to Interstate 80 north. Exit from Interstate 80 onto Highway 113 north (Woodland). Take the first exit (Hutchison Drive) and bear right (east) on Hutchison Drive. Turn right at the first stop light (LaRue Road). Follow LaRue Road to the first right turn (Garrod Drive). Follow Garrod Drive to the stop sign. After stopping, proceed directly ahead. The Client parking lot entrance is on your right. Client parking is free as long as you park in a designated 'Patient Parking' space. There are three different reception stations and it is important to come to the station mentioned when you made your appointment or as directed in your reminder letter. Reception **station 3** is in the building on your left as you drive toward the parking lot (with the large green windows) and Reception **stations 1 and 2** are in the main hospital building which is to the west of the parking lot. Look for signs that direct you to the different Reception stations.

TROPHY DESCRIPTIONS

Each Trial:

High in Trial – Large Oak Box with Sheep or Ducks
Reserve High in Trial – Small Oak Box with Sheep or Ducks
Started, Intermediate & Advanced – 1st Place – Stuffed Duck or Sheep

Overall:

High Combined (highest combined qualifying scores from all runs from all four trials) – Large Glass serving tray.
High Scoring Champion of Record – (highest combined qualifying scores from all runs from all four trials for a breed champion) - sponsored by Vaca Valley Stockdog Club. Dog related item.
High Combined Breed Awards (highest combined qualifying scores from all runs from all four trials; must have at least two of the specified breed entered to qualify) – Glass breed head study.
High Combined Started Dog (highest combined qualifying scores from all runs from all four trials. Must enter sheep and ducks to qualify) – sponsored by Debbie Pollard. Dog related item.

ADDITIONAL TEST/TRIAL REGULATIONS

Telegraph, telephone, FAX and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry forms are not acceptable. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies and conditions to its acceptance. Entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted after entries have closed. RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee.

Declination of entries: The NCBCF may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or any other cause and no one shall claim or recourse against the NCBCF or any official thereof.

All entries with fees will not be refunded in the event the dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge or barred from participation by action of the show committee. Owners or owners' agents are responsible for errors on entry forms and no refunds will be made. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the club, it is impossible to open or complete the test/trial, no refund will be given.

Only dogs entered in the test/trial are allowed on the grounds. All dogs must be held on leash or crated except when being tested or trialed.

All dogs present will be subject to the requirements of Chapter 1, Section 20 of the AKC Regulations for Herding Tests and Trials.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere as closely as possible to the judging schedule. Dogs must be ready for their classes, the club has no responsibility or obligation for providing through a P.A. system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the arena when required.

Exhibitors must be governed by any rules or regulations of civil authorities, training center rules and parking restrictions. Continuation of this event at Herding-4-Ewe is contingent upon leaving the grounds in a clean and orderly condition.

Please respect and do not destroy the test/trial site. And please, clean up after your dog!

AKC HERDING RULES AND REGULATIONS, SECTION 13. CLOSING OF ENTRIES/ALTERNATES LIST & MOVE UPS

Whenever test or trial entry limits have been reached, all additional entries that are received prior to the closing date shall be added to an alternates list for each class that exceeds the published limit(s). Entries shall be added to their respective alternates list in the order that they are received and published in the catalog. No entries shall be added after the closing time and date specified in the premium list. The Herding Secretary shall notify all entrants of their positions and the alternates list at the time the test/trial program is mailed to each entrant. Those alternates that do not run or do not have the opportunity to run shall have their fees returned.

The alternates list shall be used to fill vacancies that occur in the drawn running order, with the first available alternate entry replacing the first vacancy in the class entered.

Entrants on the alternates list must check in with the Herding Secretary on the grounds no later than 30 minutes before the commencement of their class. Note: Requests to move-up must be given to the Herding Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the event. Alternates must run in their respective classes if present and if provided with the opportunity to run.

In tests and for move-ups from a test class to a trial class, alternates shall be given priority over dogs that are eligible to be moved-up. Within the trial classes, requests to move-up shall be given priority over alternate entries.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.
